

# Big Six Rules

Big Six is one of the simplest games to play.

The wheel is divided a number of equal segments separated by pins, as follows:

"40" ( x 40) - 2 spots, 2 chances to win

"20" ( x 20) - 2 spots, 2 chances to win

"10" ( x 10) - 4 spots, 4 chances to win

"5" ( x 5) - 7 spots, 7 chances to win

"2" ( x 2) - 15 spots, 15 chances to win

"1" ( x 1) - 27 spots, 27 chances to win

54 spots

## How to play

1. The player places bets on the bills on the table. (See photo below)
2. The dealer spins the wheel.
3. The dealer gives the bell a ring before the pointer stops into a spot.  
(The player can not bet once the bell is rung.)
4. The pointer stops and then the dealer calls the winning number.
5. The dealer determines payouts, then you do it all again!!
